



# HELP US EXPLORE THE FUTURE OF TRANSPORTATION FUNDING IN GEORGIA!

Did you know that the fuel tax you pay at the pump is largely responsible for funding a well-functioning transportation system that can get you to where you need to go, delivers packages to your door, and keeps groceries on the shelves? Currently, the state funding used to maintain and operate transportation infrastructure in Georgia largely comes from a fuel tax paid by drivers on each gallon of fuel. As vehicles go farther on less fuel and some stop using any fuel at all, it will be harder to maintain Georgia's transportation system.

The Eastern Transportation Coalition (Coalition) is partnering with the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) to evaluate if a mileage-based user fee (MBUF) could be a good alternative to the traditional state fuel tax to ensure a high-quality transportation system well into the future while preserving the "user pays" method to fund transportation.

To better understand how an MBUF program could work, the Coalition is conducting an exploratory Pilot in Georgia, and they want you to tell them what you think! You will have the opportunity to test cutting-edge technology and help determine if an MBUF could be a transportation funding solution in Georgia and throughout the East Coast. This pilot is a simulation, so you'll never be asked nor required to pay anything, and there are strict privacy protection measures to safeguard your data. Here's how to join the Pilot in four easy steps:



- 1. Enroll** - Fill out the enrollment form by clicking the link on the website.
- 2. Insert** - Plug a small device into your vehicle to record mileage or enable your in-vehicle telematics.
- 3. Drive** - Carry on with your normal driving activities.
- 4. Return** - After a few months, mail the device back or disable the embedded vehicle telematics.

*These steps may vary depending on the mileage-reporting option selected.*
