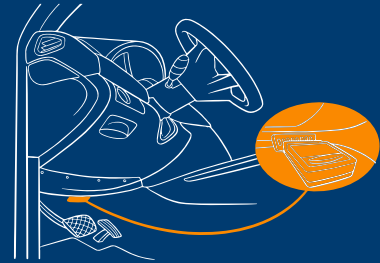


DEVICE INSTALLATION

Thank you for your participation in the Mileage-Based User Fee (MBUF) Pilot! Installation of the plug-in device is simple and quick.

1. Make sure your vehicle is parked outside with the ignition OFF and with a clear view of the sky to ensure proper GPS location and/or cell coverage.
2. Firmly plug the device into your vehicle's OBD-II port, typically located under the driver's side dashboard. The device will begin flashing to indicate it is connected.
3. Allow two minutes for the device initialization to complete, then turn the ignition ON for 30 seconds.
4. Your plug-in device is now installed and you are officially connected to the Pilot. You may turn your vehicle off or take your first trip.



I. Locate Your Port

Your vehicle's OBD-II port is an outlet often located under the dashboard.

II. Plug In the Device

Ensure it is installed securely and is not loose.

Port may be covered and the location may vary.

Verify Your Device is Connected

Once you've taken your first trip, you can log on to your participant dashboard account at ruc.transurban.io/signin and click on the **My Trips** tab to review your driving.
