Stakeholder Voices Steer MBUF Progress

In 2017, the Coalition established an MBUF Steering Committee to guide its MBUF work. Members include all participating grant states, as well as representatives from relevant national-level stakeholder organizations. Since inception, the MBUF Steering Committee has convened approximately twice per year to actively shape the direction of MBUF activities. Each meeting features in-depth presentations on MBUF developments both within the Coalition region and nationwide, breakout sessions to gather input on critical topics—such as rate setting, compliance and enforcement, and legislative strategy—and full-group discussions to synthesize insights.

The MBUF Steering Committee is essential in ensuring the wide range of viewpoints, beyond the state grant partners, are considered in shaping the Coalition’s MBUF efforts. These include perspectives related to auto associations, legislative bodies, the construction industry, motor carrier groups, underrepresented populations, and EV organizations.
